

Whether you are a member or a visitor, worshiping with us in-person or online, you are welcome here.


Information about our church is found in the narthex or online: eastminsterchurch.org. At the welcome table or on our website, you can sign up for our weekly emails.


Congregational Meeting—January 28

Dr. Eleanore Kue was born in Cameroon. She studied medicine in France and moved to the USA in the 90s. She resides in Lansing where she works as a bi-vocational pastor and physician. It was in 2007, that Dr. Eleanore came back to the USA with a desire to open a clinic for the underinsured. His Healing Hands Clinic was

opened November 2009. Shortly after, Dr. Eleanore planted His Healing Hands church at the clinic to meet the spiritual needs of her patients.
