


Service for the Lord's Day October 5, 2025

Open our hearts.


Expand our understanding.

World Communion

Today is World Communion Sunday. This day is observed on the first Sunday of October to celebrate Christian unity and diversity worldwide, bringing Christians together from different cultures and denominations at the table of the Lord's Supper. The observance was first started by Presbyterians in the 1930s and was later adopted by other denominations like Methodists and the United Church of Christ.
